Reason for Election:

The office of Divisional Councillor (No. 2 Division) is a casual vacancy.

Elected by:

The electorate for the Divisional Councillor (No. 2 Division) comprises the membership of the Coppabella, Jilalan, Moranbah and Pring sub branches. The electoral system employed is a direct voting system.

Election Date:

No specific dates are prescribed for the conduct of the elections. The rules referenced below refer to the time periods required for the functions of calling for nominations, and the time period between the opening and closing of the ballot, if required.

RULE No[s] 24(3); 24(4); 24(20).

We wish to arrange for this election to be conducted simultaneously with the elections for State Secretary, Divisional Councillor (No. 1 Division), Proxy Divisional Councillor (No. 1 Division) and Proxy Divisional Councillor (No. 2 Division) that were approved by Delegate Enright on 18 August 2014.

The elected officers do not commence their positions until **1 January 2015**. We would like to plan for the election results to be declared by **31 December 2013**.

Closure of the Roll of Voters:

The day on which the roll of voters is to be closed is 30 days before the day on which nominations open - Rule 24(11)(b)(ii).

The rules require the result of election to be decided by:

First past the post system – RULE No(s) 24(30a, b, c, d); 24(34).
