(b) The reason for the election is that the term of office is due to expire.

(c) As listed in (a) above.

(d) The electorates for the five Vice-Presidents are as follows – one each elected respectively by and from:

(1) Members employed in NSW in early childhood services.

- (2) Members employed in NSW in schools or as an advisor, supervisor or education officer by or under the supervision of a Catholic diocese but excluding members included in paragraph (d).
- (3) Members employed in NSW in a school or educational institution other than an early childhood service or a school or educational institution under the supervision of a Catholic Diocese but excluding members in sub-paragraph (d) of this paragraph;
- (4) Members employed in NSW as school support staff, (including school secretaries, clerical assistants or school assistants); boarding house staff (other than teachers); grounds or maintenance staff; canteen staff and members in other related classifications.
- (5) Members employed in the Australian Capital Territory.

The electorate for the positions of Deputy President and alternate delegate to Federal Executive is the Branch Executive.

- (e) The electorate for all other positions is the full membership (the complete roll of voters).
- (f) The time frame proposed by the organisation and as required in the rules of the organisation (see generally Federal Rule 17 and NSW/ACT Branch Rule 10) for all positions except Deputy President and Alternate Delegate to Federal Executive is as follows:
 - (i) Publication date is **Monday 16 July 2019**.
 - (ii) Nominations to open Tuesday 17 July 2019 and close 4.00pm Tuesday 7 August 2019. (see Federal Rule 17 (h) and Branch Rule 10.8 (b)).
 - (iii) The roll of voters shall close 4.00pm Monday 8 July 2019. (Federal Rule 17 (q)).
 - (iv) The ballot to Commence Wednesday 28 August 2019 and close noon Wednesday 18 September 2019.


The elections for the positions of Deputy President and alternate delegate to Federal Executive, conducted by and from the Branch Executive, should be completed as soon as possible thereafter (Branch Rule 10.12).

- (g) The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the elections for the Branch Executive and the delegates to Federal Council is a direct voting system.

The voting system for the positions of alternate delegate to Federal Executive and Deputy President is collegiate.
