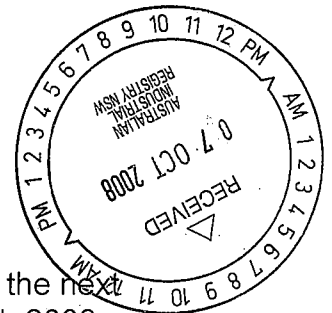

**RE: Election of Office Holders for the
Motor Traders' Association of New South Wales**

I am writing to you to request that you arrange for the election of Office Holders of the Association. The election is required to be held under the Rules of the Association and under subsection 189(3) of Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996.

The following information for the election is provided as required by RAO regulation 138.

- a) The positions are:-
 - Division Councillors – Rule 29,
 - Division Alternate Councillors – Rule 29,
 - Office Bearers – Rule 30, and
 - Secretary – Rule 35B.
- b) The election is required as the term of office is due to expire at the next Annual General Meeting which is scheduled to be held in March 2009.
- c) The Associations rules sets out the election process for the positions as follows:
 - Councillors and Alternate Councillors are elected from the members of each Division as set out by Rule 39.
 - Executive Board members are elected from the Councillors elect as set out by Rule 40.

e) The voting system employed by the Association is in the case of:

- The Councillors and Alternate Councillors the first stage of a collegiate voting system.
- The Executive Board is the second stage of a collegiate voting system.
