*Arrangement for conduct of election.*

[1] On 12 July 2019 the Police Federation of Australia-South Australia Police Branch lodged with the Registered Organisations Commission prescribed information for an election to fill a casual vacancy in the following office for the remainder of the term:

Branch Annual Conference Delegates for the Mount Gambier Workgroup (1)

[2] On 22 July 2019 I issued a decision (in **E2019/134**) arranging for an election for other vacant offices in the Branch (arising from a casual vacancy and insufficient nominations). It is apparent to the Registered Organisations Commission (ROC) that it would be both timely and efficient for the Australian Electoral Commission to consider conducting this election (E2019/142) concurrently with the election arranged in matter E2019/134.

[3] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed office is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.
