I, Fiorino (Fury) Bortolotto, being the President of the Victorian Automobile Chamber of Commerce, declare the following:

1. I am authorised to make this declaration under the Constitution of the Victorian Automobile Chamber of Commerce.
2. The following is a correct statement of the changes made to the information contained in the records required to be kept by the organisation in accordance with s.230(1)(b), (c), and (d) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* and regulation 147 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009*:
 - a. On 26 June 2018, alterations to the Constitution of the Victorian Automobile Chamber of Commerce were approved by the Fair Work Commission, (R 2018 /132).
 - b. The Constitution in **Rule 40** prescribed transitional arrangements which applied from the adoption of the alterations, including:

i. Rule 40 (b):

"The members of the executive board and board of management of the Association in place immediately prior the approval of this Constitution under the Act shall continue in those positions until the next Annual General Meeting following such approval at which time all executive board and the board of management members will resign and thereafter the positions on the:

- *Executive Board; and*
- *Industry Policy Council*

shall be filled by an inaugural election in accordance with clause 32, and thereafter filled, vacated and otherwise dealt with in accordance with this Constitution."

ii. Rule 40 (c):

"For the avoidance of doubt, after the next Annual General Meeting following the approval of this Constitution, the executive board and the board of management in place immediately prior to the approval of this Constitution shall be replaced by the Executive Board and the Industry Policy Council and shall cease to exist in their current form."

- c. The Annual General Meeting of Victorian Automobile Chamber of Commerce was held on 28 November 2018. At this meeting the election of members to the new Executive Board and Industry Policy Council were declared. In accordance with Rule 40 (c) of the Constitution, the Board of Management ceased to exist. This transition resulted in changes to offices of the Victorian Automobile Chamber of Commerce.

- d. A list of changes to offices and the names, postal addresses and occupations of persons holding these offices is attached to this declaration at **Annexure A** and forms part of this declaration.


