Rules used for the election: 191V: Incorporates alterations of [24/12/2009]  
[R2009/10000] (replaces 21/12/2005 version)

Rules difficult to apply/interpret: **Rule 85(3)** - Where a ballot for any office is required, the Returning Officer shall declare the successful candidates at the annual general meeting when all results are known, that is, at the completion of any ballot or ballots, where one or more is necessary (p21). This rule does not occur in practice and has the ability to hinder the timely completion of subsequent elections when ballots occur. It also leaves a very large time span between the declaration of results and annual general meeting when a ballot for a contested office does not occur. For these reasons it is recommended that this rule is removed or altered to reflect that the election has concluded when the Returning Officer declares the results, which shall occur as soon as practicable after they are known.

It is also recommended that a rule is inserted to formalise the historical practice of candidates providing 'Pen Pictures,' consisting of photographs and candidate statements, to the organisation. The insertion of a rule to govern this would enable the Australian Electoral Commission to receive these and ensure all pictures and statements from candidates met the set criteria, thereby making the process more transparent.

Furthermore, it is recommended that if the A Grade Board of Examiners division no longer exists that it is removed entirely from the rules and therefore future elections.


